

The Central Missouri Humane Society is seeking a mission driven Veterinarian to join our caring and compassionate team. This position provides high-quality medical care to shelter animals, including spay/neuter and treatment of various medical conditions. The Veterinarian is also responsible for developing, advancing, and implementing shelter medicine protocols and ensuring humane medical treatment of all animals at CMHS

#### Duties included but not limited to

- Ensure high-quality medical care and services for shelter animals
- Perform and/or supervise spay/neuter surgeries and other medical surgery procedures as required for CMHS animals, our low cost program, and community TNR program. Provide follow-up on post surgical complications
- Provide recommendations on adequate quarantine procedures, vaccinations, and sanitation practices to control infectious disease in the shelter
- Provide medical treatment, vaccinations and animal cruelty court testimony for animal control as described in the Boone County/City of Columbia contract
- Assist with vaccination clinics and other special events as needed

#### Qualifications

- Degree of Veterinary Medicine from an accredited University.
- License to practice in the State of Missouri or be eligible to successfully obtain a license to practice.
- Have or have the ability to obtain a DEA license for controlled substances.
- Experience in shelter medicine or high-volume spay/neuter clinics preferred
